Bishop Arts Theatre Center Teen Advisory Council is designed for thought-leaders ages 13-18 who are interested in art, culture, and community engagement. The council encourages youth to take on new challenges to help shape the next generation of leaders and professionals through engaging interactive peer-to-peer art experiences.

<p>Youth Voices are shared and valued: Youth contribute new ideas for activities and are encouraged to try them out.</p>					
<p>Youth participate in authentic decision-making: Youth create ideas or contents for subject learning and decisions.</p>					
<p>Youth have key leadership roles or responsibilities: Youth take on key leadership roles and responsibilities that further develop their skills and networks.</p>					

<p>All youth participate fully in the conversation: All youth are encouraged to present the work. Youth may decline the opportunity to speak up based on their own comfort level but their full participation is present.</p>					
<p>Youth develop a sense of community through program involvement: Youth identify themselves as an active member of the group or the overall program.</p>					
<p>Youth are active contributors to the community: Youth participate in activities that support themselves, the program, and the community.</p>					
<p>Youth gain essential social capital through program involvement: The activities provide youth with meaningful opportunities to engage in communities outside of the</p>					

organization. Collaboration includes planning or working together so youth can enhance their skills or networks.					
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1 = Beginner, 2 = Developing, 3 = Accomplished, 4 = Exemplary

[Note: For each category, the teacher would simply check one of the four boxes, then write comments to the side, describing the specific factors that influenced the score. For example, if “2” was checked, the comment box might include phrases like “not enough transitions” on a writing assignment, or “feet too close together” for a P.E. task.]
